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Chapter I - Introduction

The purpose of these Instructions for Continued Airworthiness (ICA) is to provide the maintenance technician's with the information necessary to ensure the continued airworthiness of the Beechcraft OEM Cabinetry installed with Aviation Fabricator's PMA foot and spacer fittings per drawing D-10554.

Modification of the aircraft by installing these fittings obligates the aircraft operator to include the maintenance information provided by this document in the operator's Aircraft Maintenance Manual and the operator's Aircraft Scheduled Maintenance Program.

Chapter II – Inspection / Maintenance Instructions

To comply with FAR 23.1529 continue the modified cabinetry on the same inspection and maintenance schedule as was previously used per the Beechcraft Maintenance Manual.

The use of the spacer and foot fitting does not change the dimensions of the installed furniture item. Access to the fasteners is from the top of the mounting panel, and the fitting is below the panel, installed in the airplane seat track. Follow the published instructions for removal of the furniture in the Hawker Beechcraft Maintenance Manual or other approved airplane data.
